Free School Meals

The process of applying for Free School Meals at Rednal Hill Junior is clear and straightforward and may be done online or via Mrs Billingsley in the School Office. Parents/Carers need to be in receipt of one of the following benefits to be considered eligible:

- Income Support (IS)
- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance (IBJSA)
- •Child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income that does not exceed £16,190 (as assessed by HMRC)
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- •Income Related Employment Support Allowance
- •Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (from the National Asylum Support Service)

NB: Working Tax Credits do not qualify you for Free School Meals unless granted to cover the four-week period immediately after employment ceases, or if the hours worked are less than 16 hours per week.

When your child joins year 3, the Government programme that entitles children in the infant phase to a free school meal each day no longer applies.

As you are aware, this scheme was offered at no cost to all parents and I know how many appreciated the opportunity for children to enjoy cooked meals at lunchtime. Your child may still be eligible for free school meals

If you receive a government benefit, such as Income Support or Jobseeker's Allowance, your child may still qualify for a free school meal. You can apply directly for free school meals and check your eligibility on https://www.cloudforedu.org.uk/ofsm/birmingham
