FIRST AID IN SCHOOL



If a child has a small injury that requires first aid, they will receive a pink or blue slip from us to inform you of that injury. The blue slip will inform you of any head injury and offers advice about monitoring your child. If your child appears unwell following injury or if it a more serious injury we will contact you immediately.

The pink slip will be for any other first aid received.

The slips will inform you that your child has received first aid for minor injuries. A text will be sent out to inform you that your child will be bringing a first aid letter home. If your child requires first aid at the end of the day, you will not receive a text and a member of staff will send the slip out with your child.

Please be aware that for anything other than a minor injury or if we have any cause for concern, we will contact you by phone.
