# Illness and First Day Call

If your child is ill, please can you ring the school by 9:00 am and leave an absence message (option 1).

If your child is off school as they have been vomiting or have vomiting & diarrhoea, they are to be kept off school until they have not been sick (or have had diarrhoea) for at least 48

hours.

If you don't ring us to inform us that your child will be off school, we have to follow our attendance procedures. This will mean a First Day Call and/or a Home Visit. Please see our attendance policy on our website for further information.
