#### Dear families...

As we approach the end of term, this will be the last weekly newsletter from Rednal Juniors. The weekly newsletter was created in an attempt to keep families and children connected to our school at a time of potential isolation through the sharing of children's work, keeping families 'up-to-date' and general positivity. From September we will move back to a half-termly newsletter and other letters as and when necessary.

#### Phone calls & ongoing support for pupil and family well-being

Our other method of keeping connected with families at home has been our regular phone calls from school staff. Please note, our supplementary learning projects will cease next week.
