



Is encouraging others to donate to charity as good as giving yourself?




#### **Creative thinking**

#### **Talking Points**

- Which one of them would you like to do most?
- What other things could you do to help others?
- o Could you even help people you don't know?

#### Activity

- On a big sheet of paper, draw or paint all the different ways people could help each other.
- Cut them out and show them at school or to your friends. Ask them what they could do too.
